THE ART OF FIRE MEMBERSHIP (GLASSBLOWING)

This membership includes the use of the glass furnace, torches, annealing kiln, studio glassblowing pipes & tools on select dedicated rental days booked 1 week in advance.

Glassblowing rentals and membership participants must own their own sleeves. Fuel charges, support staff and glass weight per daily use is not included these fees are due post bench time weigh out

Memberships for the Fire it Up and the Art of Fire must be approved by the studio owner or lead glassblower.
